Tues, May 16 | 12:00-1:00 pm | Zinner Breakout Room

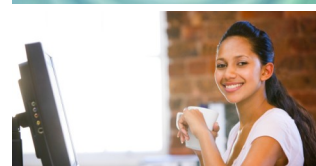

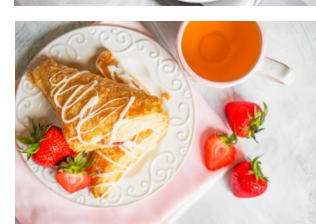
